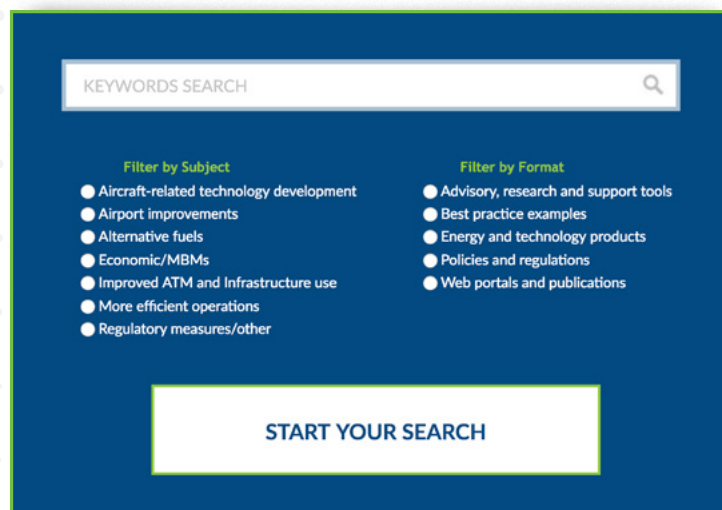


ICAO KNOWLEDGE SHARING PLATFORM

Under the framework of the ICAO-UNDP-GEF project, ICAO has developed a knowledge sharing platform to facilitate access to the most relevant information on low CO₂ emissions aviation measures.

The ICAO Knowledge Sharing Platform brings together the latest and most relevant information on climate mitigation efforts in aviation. It also creates a space for the aviation community to share and discuss its experience in the implementation of low CO₂ emissions measures. By combining this collective knowledge, the ICAO Knowledge Sharing Platform empowers developing and Small Island Developing States (SIDS) that are the most vulnerable to climate change impacts.

A search on the platform returns all relevant resources that may include projects, policies, guidance documents, tools and outreach initiatives. More than one thousand resources are accessible via the platform. From the list of search results, individual initiatives can be selected in order to obtain more information and determine whether it would apply to your circumstances.





The Knowledge Sharing Platform is a resource for international aviation stakeholders to identify measures and strategies for reducing CO₂ emissions. It can be used as a resource for States in developing their State Action Plan on CO₂ Emissions Reduction from International Aviation or by other aviation stakeholders to identify low CO₂ emissions strategies.
