
## What is CRV?

- The concept Common Regional Virtual Private Network (CRV) came from the common network already implemented in many regions such as Pan-European Network (PEN), FAA Telecommunication Infrastructure (FTI), etc.
- This concept of common network for APAC region was proposed in ATNICG/8 and then APANPIRG/24.


## What is CRV?

- CRV is a dedicated Multiprotocol Label Switching (MPLS) IP VPN network.
- Scalable/Manageable IP VPN network supporting all AFS in APAC region.
- Coverage of CRV is over the whole APAC region.
- Single (or limited) network service providers.
- Dedicated network operation center for management of the CRV.
- Support concept of SWIM in the future.

## Who is CRV TF?

• APANPIRG CRV TF was proposed by a number of States at the ATNICG/8 and APANPIRG/24, as a dedicated task force to study regional virtual private network (VPN) and develop a detailed proposal by January 2016.

## Term of Reference of CRV TF

- Develop and propose to the APANPIRG a multinational agreement proposing the organizational policies and procedures for managing the regional network including inter-regional coordination;
- Study and propose to the APANPIRG the concept of operation for common VPN for APAC Region including cost-benefit consideration;
- Develop the RFI to be distributed to interested service providers and analyze questions/information received from RFI;
- Develop the Request For Proposal (RFP) for common VPN for APAC Region and evaluate/select the best proposal; and
- Develop the procedures for commissioning common VPN for APAC Region.
