## **MEETING BULLETIN**

#### 1. Dates and Meeting Venue

**1.1** The Third Meeting of the ICAO Asia/Pacific Search and Rescue Task Force (APSARTF/3) will be held at Hulhule Island Hotel (HIH) in Maldives from Sunday, 25-29 January 2015. The meeting will start at 0900am each day. Hulhule Island Hotel is a hotel located at the Ibrahim Nasir International Airport.

#### 2. Registration of Delegates

- **2.1** Delegates are requested to register at the Registration Desk located at the entrance of the conference hall between 0830 and 0900 hours on the opening day of the Meeting.
- **2.2** Designated badges will be issued to delegates after registration. Delegates are required to wear the badges throughout the period of the Meeting for easy identification.

## 3. Useful travel information

#### 3.1 Visa and Entry Requirements for Maldives

To enter Maldives no pre-arrival visa is required.

A 30-day free visa is issued on arrival for all Nationalities, provided the following conditions are met:

- Should possess a valid passport; and
- Have a valid ticket to continue the journey out of Maldives; and
- Have a confirmed reservation in a tourist resort, hotel or a guest house and enough funds to cover the expense for the stay.

#### 3.2 Currency and Credit Cards

The Maldivian Rufiya (MRF) is the official local currency and is equivalent to the US Dollar at the rate of MRF15.42 to US\$1.

Use only authorized money changers, a bank or requests your hotel for money exchange and always obtains a receipt.

Credit cards such as American Express, Diners Club, Visa, Master, etc. are accepted at hotels, most of the shops and restaurants.

ATM network is available at the airport and in the capital island Male' and are connected to international banking networks.

#### 3.3 Language

The official language is Dhivehi and English is widely spoken in the service industry.

### 3.4 Weather

Maldives enjoys warm tropical weather with little variation throughout the year. Average day time temperature is  $30^{\circ}$ C dropping down to  $26^{\circ}$  C at night time. Light weight summer clothing is recommended.

#### **3.5 Electricity**

Electricity is 230 volts, 50Hz. Most sockets accept rectangular blade plugs (UK style).

#### 3.6 Water

Water from public mains meets international health standards. Electric kettles are available in most hotels. Bottled water is readily available in local convenient stores and supermarkets.

SIM cards for mobile phones can be purchased at the airport and from convenience stores.

# 5 Transportation

Upon arrival, delegates are requested to report to the airport information desk located near the arrival exit. MCAA official will receive the delegate and transportation arrangement between airport and the hotel will be arranged.

Hulhule Island Hotel (HIH) (Meeting venue) is located less than 5 minutes travel by bus from the airport and complimentary hotel shuttle buses are available round the clock for the convenience of the guests. The closest island Male', the capital city is 10 minutes boat ride away from the airport island.

# For delegates staying in Male' (Capital City)

Local boats or Dhonis are the most common means of water transport but high speed transport is also available from the Airport to the Capital city Male' which is just 10 minutes (a kilometer) from the Airport. Scheduled transfers between Airport and Male':

- By ferry boat which departs every 10 minutes (standard fare MRF 10 = US\$ 1 and takes 10 minutes)
- By speed boat which departs every 15 minutes (standard fare MRF 25 = US\$ 2 and takes 5 minutes)
