SUMMARY

This paper presents a brief overview of Phase Two of the "IATA ATFM Project" endorsed at ATFM/SG/4 by decision 4/3, which consists of Task One – Compilation of Cross Border ATFM Implementation Plan and Task Two – ATFM /CDM Workshops

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 ATFM/SG/4 agreed to support Phase Two of the "IATA ATFM Project" through Decision 4/3:

ATFM/SG Decision 4/3: IATA Asia Pacific Regional Air Traffic Flow Management Project – Phase Two:

The Asia Pacific Air Traffic Flow Management Steering Group agrees to support Phase Two of the IATA Regional Air Traffic Flow Management Project that will:

- develop a regional cross-border ATFM implementation plan in harmonization with existing cross-border ATFM implementation projects for consideration by the ATFM Steering Group and States at ATFM/SG/5; and
- develop in cooperation with ICAO a program to advocate for and educate stakeholder groups on cross border regional ATFM through a series of workshops partially funded by IATA (provision of SMEs) and logistically supported by States (e.g. venue provision).

1.2 This paper provides ATFM/SG/5 with an update of progress on the project and expected timeline for delivery of outcomes.

2. DISCUSSION

Task One: "Cross Border Regional ATFM/CDM Implementation Plan"

2.1 Airbus ProSky has been retained as the consultant for Phase Two of the project.

2.2 The Cross Border Regional ATFM/CDM implementation plan will build on the high level strategy developed during Phase One and provide a more detailed plan for consideration by the ATFM/SG and States.

2.3 It is expected that the Roadmap document will be completed in June 2015

Task Two: "ATFM/CDM Workshops" (in partnership with ICAO)

2.4 The workshop program and format is yet to be agreed but initial thinking and dates are as follows.

2.5 It is proposed there are 4, two-day workshops (**Table 1**):

Workshop Focus and Format
