ICAO/IATA/CANSO GO Team Visit

(Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates, 12-23 January 2014)

Action Required: Reply not later than 15 December 2013

Sir,

I have the honor to invite your organization to participate in the upcoming Middle East Performance-based Navigation (PBN) Go Team visit. Noting the significant benefits of implementation of PBN and as follow-up to the implementation seminars/workshops undertaken in the past, ICAO in partnership with IATA and CANSO will be conducting a PBN Go Team visit from 12-23 January 2014, in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates (UAE). The visit will be kindly hosted by the UAE General Civil Aviation Authority at their new Sheikh Zayed Centre.

This visit will provide instruction/discussion in 2 main areas, as follows:

- 1) Airspace Planning Concept Workshop, 12-23 January; and
- 2) PBN Operations Approval, 19-23 January.

The Airspace Planning Concept Workshop is essential for all Stakeholders involved with Airspace Design utilizing PBN. It will provide best practices from the PBN Manual (Doc 9613), Continuous Descent Operations (CDO) Manual (DOC 9931) and Continuous Climb Operations (CCO) Manual (Doc 9993). It will also include training in civil/military cooperation in the use of airspace. Consequently, it is important that the participants be officials from ANSPs, the Military, Regulators, Airlines, Airport Authorities, Instrument Procedure Designers, etc. Prior to attending this Airspace Workshop, participants are required to undergo an ICAO web-based training package which should take no more than 2 hours to complete. The link to the package is as follows: <a href="http://goo.gl/XVJI1X">http://goo.gl/XVJI1X</a>. On the last day, participants will be presented with a certificate of attendance.

The PBN Operations Approval course is a train-the-trainer session, based on the PBN Operations Approval Manual (Doc 9997) and aimed at experienced flight inspectors and flight operations regulators. Its purpose is to provide participants with comprehensive understanding of the requirements for PBN operational approval and comprises five days of classroom lecture, with opportunities for detailed discussion about relevant issues. Prior to attending the course, participants are required to undertake an ICAO web-based training package which should take no more than 8 hours to complete. On the last day, participants will be tested on their knowledge of the course material and certificate of attendance will be issued. Within a year of completing the course, participants are expected to run an equivalent course for flight operations regulatory staff in their home State. The Go Team visit will be conducted in the English Language. The programme for the visit, as well as the bulletin providing information for participants including the hotel list will be provided in due course. As space is limited for each course, participants will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis; it is important to indicate your interest to participate and encourage your candidates to register as soon as possible.

Please note that all course documentation will be provided in electronic format (no paper based copies). It is therefore necessary for all participants to have their own computer with them to facilitate their participation.
