1.1 The PBN implementation Plan facilitates an efficient, globally harmonized and coordinated transition from conventional navigation towards RNAV and RNP applications in all phases of flight.

2.1 Egypt updated its PBN plan as well as PBN roadmap to be aligned with the ASBU and Block 0 and Block 1 through short term plan (2014), MID term plan (~ 2016) and long term plan (2017 ~), especially the global air navigating priorities:

- Performance Based Navigation (PBN); (a first priority)
- Continuous Descent and Climb Operations (CDO/CCO); and
- Air Traffic Flow Management (ATFM)

2.2 The Presentation by Egypt reflects the current situation of Egyptian airspace, why Egypt need PBN plan, what are the updates on Egyptian PBN plan, Challenges of implementation and Egyptian strategy.
