1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Modern technologies and publishing tolls for aeronautical information, especially in the form of eAIP, where digital aeronautical information and aeronautical data of high integrity, quality and accuracy are exchanged in real-time, requires a new sort of aeronautical information publishing priorities within the sophistic equipped requirements.

1.2 The products of AIS or AIM for that matter is still the same but the manner of delivering these products have changed, it is therefore imperative that we, as a service provider, should change the way we do our business. By doing so, we have to prepare our workforce to be significantly improve the quality of provision the information service within the local users in the region.

1.3 The challenge is now upon us to close the gap between those how are using the eAIP portals in English language (the defaulting language) and between those who are still prefer using the local language in their daily working to enable a seamless transition from AIS to AIM.

1.4 Like in every region, we in the Middle East region are also concerned of these requirements. There should be regulatory provisions and cooperative approach to prioritizing the publishing of eAIP for the state.

1.5 It is noted that some states in our region publishing their eAIP only in other language than English (Algeria, Argentina, and some other states upload only by local language).
