

### 1. Introduction

1.1 Serious Incident is defined in ICAO Annex 13 as an incident involving circumstances indicating that an accident nearly occurred (examples of serious incidents can be found in Attachment C of ICAO Annex 13.

#### 2. DISCUSSION

2.1 According to ICAO iSTARS (ADREP et al.), 13 Serious Incidents were reported during the period (2010-2014). The following chart shows the risk distribution for each year:



2.2 It is to be highlighted that the number of reported Serious Incidents for the period (2010-2014) reflects insufficient reporting to ICAO.
