## 7. Banking and Currency

7.1 The local currency unit is Moroccan Dirham (MAD) Approximately 1 Euro = 10,85MAD and 1\$= 9,79MAD

7.2 Currency can be exchanged at the main banks agencies and exchange agencies in the city. MasterCard and VISA cards are generally accepted in hotels, restaurants and shopping centres.

7.3 Banks are available at the airport and near the course venue.

8.1 During May, the mean daily minimum temperature is 12°C and the daily mean maximum temperature is 23°C.

9.1 220 Volts/50 Hertz using standard European type plug.
