MET DEFICIENCIES IN THE MID REGION

(Presented by the Secretariat)

SUMMARY

This paper provides a status of MET Deficiencies in the MID Region.

Action by the meeting is at paragraph 3.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The meeting will recall the MIDANPIRG Air Navigation Deficiency Database (MANDD) which contains a list of deficiencies that includes MET. The MIDANPIRG/15 meeting agreed to include the following States to the list of deficiencies since Quality Management System (QMS) for MET had not been implemented as per paragraph 2.2 of Annex 3: Iran, Iraq, Lebanon, Libya, Oman, Syria and Yemen. Existing OPMET deficiencies (30-hour TAF not available internationally for HEOW (Egypt), 24-hour TAF not available internationally for OSAP (Syria)) remained. One OPMET deficiency (METAR not available internationally for ORSU (Iraq)) was removed from the MANDD.

1.2 MIDANPIRG/15 reviewed the outcome of the different MIDANPIRG subsidiary bodies related to air navigation deficiencies and agreed to the following Conclusion to replace and supersede the MIDANPIRG/14 Conclusion 14/32:

CONCLUSION 15/35: AIR NAVIGATION DEFICIENCIES

That, States be urged to:

- a) use the MID Air Navigation Deficiency Database (MANDD) for the submission of requests for addition, update, and elimination of Air Navigation Deficiencies, including the submission of a specific Corrective Action Plan (CAP) for each deficiency; and
- b) submit a Formal Letter to the ICAO MID Regional Office containing the evidence(s) that mitigation measures have been implemented for the elimination of deficiency(ies) when requesting the elimination of deficiency(ies) from the MANDD.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 The meeting is invited to provide any updates related to the deficiencies identified above and reproduced in **Appendix A**. In addition, the meeting is invited to provide any other information related to new deficiencies identified.

2.2 Lastly, the meeting may note that Iran, Lebanon and Syria do not acquire SADIS and therefore the lack of WAFS forecasts necessary for briefing and flight documentation (Annex 3, 9.1.4, 9.3.1, 9.4.1 and Appendix 2, 2.1.1) would result in a deficiency if not remedied by the MIDANPIRG/16 meeting.

2.3 The Secretariat will assist in developing a corrective action plan to any deficiencies identified noting that if those deficiencies still exist by MIDANPIRG/16, they would be considered for inclusion to the MID Air Navigation Deficiencies Database (MANDD).

3. ACTION BY THE MEETING

3.1 The meeting is invited to:

- a) review and update the list of deficiencies in the MET field; and
- b) urge States to take necessary follow-up actions to implement MIDANPIRG/15 Conclusion 15/35, in particular submission of a specific Corrective Action Plan (CAP) for each deficiency.

Note:* Priority for action to remedy a deficiency is based on the following safety assessments:

'U' priority = Urgent requirements having a direct impact on safety and requiring immediate corrective actions.

Urgent requirement consisting of any physical, configuration, material, performance, personnel or procedures specification, the application of which is urgently required for air navigation safety.

'A' priority = Top priority requirements necessary for air navigation safety.

Top priority requirement consisting of any physical, configuration, material, performance, personnel or procedures specification, the application of which is considered necessary for air navigation safety.

'B' priority = Intermediate requirements necessary for air navigation regularity and efficiency.

Intermediate priority requirement consisting of any physical, configuration, material, performance, personnel or procedures specification, the application of which is considered necessary for air navigation regularity and efficiency.

Definition:

A deficiency is a situation where a facility, service or procedure does not comply with a regional air navigation plan approved by the Council, or with related ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices, and which situation has a negative impact on the safety, regularity and/or efficiency of international civil aviation.
