- → RASG/5 Conclusion 5/3: Use of ECCAIRS
 - → That, States that have not yet done so, be urged to use ECCAIRS for the reporting of accidents and serious incidents.
- → Use of ADREP compatible system

Amendment No. 1 to Safety Management Annex (A19)

Update on implementation of amendment 1 to A19 which becomes effective on 11 July 2016 and Applicable on 7 November 2019

→ Note: 8 Critical Elements (CEs) of a State Safety Oversight (SSO) system constitute the foundation of the SSP

Challenges

- → Alignment of Qatar Regulations with EU/EASA Regulations (Strategic Planning)
- → Review of legislation (Law No. 15)
 - → Include SSP requirements
 - → Non punitive provisions



Conclusion



- → Qatar has met its commitment for the phased implementation of the SSP in accordance with the MID Region implementation strategy
- → Documents which are being finalized are:
 - → SSP document which includes the ALoSP of the State
 - → Enforcement procedures in an SSP/SMS environment
 - → Review and alignment of Law 15 and Decree 45 with EU requirements
 - → Establishment of a distinct Accident Incident Investigation mechanism under the Minister of Transport and Communication
