


SAR Implementation status within the MID Region

English is the working Language, however some States











The main Challenges are related to lack of:


- effective SAR oversight activities;

- appropriate training programmes/plans of SAR experts;
- signature of SAR agreements (current signed agreements as of March 2024 is at **Appendix A**);
- plans of operations for the conduct of SAR operations and SAR exercises;
- provision of required SAR services; and
- non-compliance with the carriage of Emergency Locator Transmitter (ELT) requirements.





SAR deficiencies in the MID Region


SAREX Lack of Provisions



Effective SAR Oversight










MID Region status of SAR Bilateral Arrangments
