



COVID-19 pandemic impacted air connectivity





MID passenger traffic








- Passenger traffic in RPKs recovered by 11.6% in 2021 after the declined by -70.9% in 2020.
- Passenger traffic recovers below the world average.

- Seat Capacity in Available Seat-Kilometres (ASKs) recovered by 20.4% in 2021 after the decline by -62.7%.
- Capacity recovers below the world average.

- Passenger load factor declined to 54.6% in 2021, below the world average.
- Passenger load factor is below the world average.




MID cargo traffic




- Cargo traffic measures in Freight Tonnes-Kilometres (FTKs) recovered by 22.2% in 2021, surpassing the 2019 result.
- FTK increased more than world average



State ranking by Revenue Passenger-Kilometres




Airline ranking by Revenue Passenger-Kilometres







Total Number of flights from MID States 2019-2023



- +21% increase in departure from Jan-March 2023 compared to the same period in 2022.
- +98% increase in departure from Jan-March 2023 compared to the same period in 2021.

Evolution of traffic – Middle East






- Passenger traffic in Middle East region in departure volume shows constant recovery since the pandemic shock in 2020.
- Scheduled passenger departure volume in 2022 recovered by 83.6% compared with 2019.
- Scheduled cargo departure volume, on the other hand, shows a slight decrease after the pandemic.




Long term traffic forecasts - Middle East (2018 baseline)

Cargo forecasts - Middle East



- Passenger traffic (RPK) CAGR 2018-2050 forecast is 4.4%, 3.0% and 4.3% for international, domestic and total, respectively
- Cargo traffic (FTK) CAGR 2018-2050 forecast is 6.0%, 2.3% and 6.0% for international, domestic and total, respectively
