Develop a clear action plan to enhance aviation safety during the next 3 years period (2023 to 2025).

Developed in collaboration with State and with industry.

- Iraq & Sudan NASPs have been successfully developed and shared with ICAO MID Office



UAS iPack main Objectives Jordan

Assist and guide ministries of transport, Civil Aviation Authorities, and organizations in developing a UAS regulatory framework

Understand the relationship between UAS regulations, conventional aircraft regulations, forthcoming RPAS provisions and the State Safety Programme

Establish a UAS framework and oversight system in collaboration with internal UAS stakeholders



- Supported Libya CAA personnel to perform PQs self-assessment, identify deficiencies, and develop corrective action plan.



Aerodrome iPack main Objectives (Libya)

The conditions of aerodrome infrastructure;

The procedures relating to aerodrome operations;

The status of aerodrome certification and compliance;

The coordination and collaboration processes required at an aerodrome; and

The aerodrome related human resources, competency and training requirements.



Aerodrome iPack main Deliverables (Libya)

An action plan to address discrepancies identified.

A dashboard for the aerodrome restart activities.

A plan for phasing out alleviations for aerodrome restart.

A report of possible changes in the areas of aerodrome operation

A plan for phasing out alleviations for aerodrome restart

Updated aeronautical information pertaining to aerodrome restart

A report of aerodrome certificate status, and the actions for its ongoing process.

Meetings for coordination with service providers and other relevant stakeholders for phased planning of restart.

Coordinated list of Groups and Committees including key stakeholders

The training needs assessment

workshop on root cause analysis and successful corrective action plans
