EXPLANATORY NOTES ON THE AGENDA FOR APANPIRG/13

Agenda Item 1: Review of Council and ANC action on APANPIRG/12 Report

The Group will review the actions taken by the ANC and Council on the Conclusions of APANPIRG/12 and may take note and/or propose further action. The Group will also review the progress made on all the Decisions and Conclusions of APANPIRG/12.

Agenda Item 2: ASIA/PAC Air Navigation system and Related Activities

2.1 <u>ATS/AIS/SAR Matters</u>

The Group will review the report of the ATS/AIS/SAR SG/12 meeting and propose actions as required. The Group will also discuss other ATS/AIS/SAR matters, if any, raised by the Members, States and the Secretariat.

2.2 <u>CNS/MET Matters</u>

The Group will review the report of the CNS/MET SG/6 meeting and propose actions as required. The Group will also discuss other CNS/MET matters, if any, raised by the Members, States and the Secretariat.

2.3 ATS CO-ordination Groups' Activities

Under this item the Group will review the results of the ATS Co-ordination Groups/Co-ordination meetings in ASIA/PAC Regions and note the progress made so far.

2.4 <u>Other Air Navigation Matters</u>

Under this item the Group will consider matters related to the Air Navigation Plans, air navigation services and facilities in the regions. In accordance with its Terms of Reference, the Group is expected review the Statement of Basic Operational Requirements and Planning Criteria and recommend to the ANC any changes required in the light of new developments in the air navigation field. The Group will also review the report of the Asia and Pacific Area Traffic Forecasting Group.

Agenda Item 3: CNS/ATM Implementation and Related Activities

Under this item, the Group will review the report of the CNS/ATM IC SG/9 meeting and propose actions as may be required. The Group will also review CNS/ATM related activities in the Asia/Pacific Regions as well as other regions.

Agenda Item 4: Deficiencies in the Air Navigation Field

The Group will note the single definition of deficiency as approved by the ICAO Council in November 2001 and to develop a list of Deficiencies in the Air Navigation System in the region and propose an action plan with target dates for remedial measures. All provider and user States, IATA and IFALPA are requested to provide inputs to the Group.

The Group will review the progress made on all outstanding Conclusions and Decisions of its previous meetings and update the list of outstanding Conclusions and Decisions which are to be watched further.

Under this item, the Group is expected to review its Terms of Reference and to develop its future work programme including those of the contributory bodies, the priorities to be assigned to its tasks and the future meeting programme.
