This working paper presents the rotational scheme for States hosting the E/CAR/DCA Meetings agreed upon by the Fourteenth Meeting of Directors of Civil Aviation of the Eastern Caribbean for updating.

1. Introduction

1.1 The Fourteenth Meeting of Directors of Civil Aviation of the Eastern Caribbean (San Juan, Puerto Rico, 9 to 12 June 1998) agreed under Conclusion 14/9 the Rotational Scheme for States hosting the Meetings of Directors of Civil Aviation of the Eastern Caribbean, which is presented with updated information in the Appendix to this working paper.

2. Discussion

2.1 In view that the approved rotational scheme for States hosting E/CAR/DCA Meetings is completed, the review and update of this scheme based on E/CAR/DCA/14 Conclusion 14/9, copied for ease of reference, would be appropriate.

CONCLUSION 14/9 SITES OF DCA MEETINGS

That,

a) beginning with the 15th DCA E/CAR Meeting, the host of the yearly DCA meetings should follow successively this rotational list, with each entity determining the actual site of the meeting:

- OECS
- French Antilles
- Trinidad and Tobago
- OECS
- Barbados
- USA
- British Virgin Islands;
- b) the other States and International Organizations normally invited to participate in the E/CAR DCA meetings can at any time offer to host a DCA meeting: Aruba, Guyana, Netherlands Antilles, Suriname, Venezuela;
- c) should a State not be able to host a particular DCA meeting, the ICAO NACC Office should be advised at least 6 months before the convening of the meeting, where upon the next State on the rotational list should take on the responsibility of hosting that meeting; and
- d) the E/CAR Working Group develop its own rotational list for its meetings, taking into consideration the E/CAR DCA rotational list shown in paragraph a).

3. Suggested Action

- 3.1 The Directors of Civil Aviation of the Eastern Caribbean are invited to:
 - a) take note of the information presented in this working paper; and
 - b) review the E/CAR/DCA Meeting rotational scheme presented in the Appendix to this paper and agree on the place of the next meeting and on a new rotational scheme.
