IMPLEMENTATION AND CERTIFICATION OF AERODROMES AND SMS

(Presented by the Secretariat)

SUMMARY

The aim of this working paper is to 1) inform the Meeting on survey results regarding status of aerodrome certification and safety management system implementation; 2) identify the importance of replying to the surveys for proper analysis by GREPECAS AGA/AOP/SG Task Forces; and 3) identify that the minimal information received from States/Territories prevents ascertaining progress achieved to date.

Strategic Objectives This working paper relates to Strategic Objective A.

1. Background

1.1 In accordance with Section 1.3, Aerodrome Certification, of Annex 14, Volume I, ICAO sets forth that States will certificate, through the appropriate regulatory framework, all their international aerodromes as from 27 November 2003.

1.2 GREPECAS, through its AGA/AOP Subgroup, has monitored the implementation of the aerodrome certification process in the CAR/SAM Regions. In this regard, GREPECAS formulated Conclusion 14/31:

CONCLUSION 14/31 AERODROME CERTIFICATION/SAFETY MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS (SMS)

That,

- a) ICAO re-circulate the surveys on Aerodrome Certification/Safety Management Systems (SMS) among States/Territories during the first semester 2007;
- b) States/Territories duly complete and return the surveys on Aerodrome Certification/Safety Management Systems (SMS) as soon as possible, and **no later** than two months after the circulation date.

1.3 Moreover, ICAO NACC Regional Office sent the referred surveys to all States in the Region on 26 June 2007, urging them to reply by 11 August 2007.

2. Discussion

2.1 The replies received to the survey on airport certification from the States of the CAR Region include: Aruba, Barbados, Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, French Antilles, Honduras, Nicaragua, Trinidad and Tobago and United States, representing 60% of the total States/Territories. The table summarising State responses is included in **Appendix A** to this paper.

2.2 In order to assist the GREPECAS AGA/AOP Subgroup to achieve expected results, States are requested to complete and submit, if applicable, the airport certification information using the format included in **Appendix B**.

2.3 In addition, replies received to the survey on SMS from the States of the CAR Region include: Barbados, Cuba and United States, representing 15% of the total States/Territories. The table summarising State responses is included in **Appendix C** to this paper. Likewise, States are requested to complete and submit their SMS information using the format included in **Appendix D**.

3. Recommendations

3.1 The Meeting is invited to:

- a) note the information provided in this working paper and its appendices; and
- b) urge States/Territories that have not yet done so, to complete and submit the information requested in Appendices B and D to the ICAO NACC Regional Office by **30 August 2008**.
