2. Opening Session/ Registration:

Registration of participants and collection of the name tags will take place on 10-12 April 2018 from 07:00am to 08:45am at Emperors Palace. The official opening of the seminar will take place at 09:00am.

3. Working Language:

The country has 11 official languages. English is the preferred language for corporate business, including at most conference centres and also with tourists.

The Workshop will be conducted in the English Language but translation will be done from English to French and vice versa.

Seminar material will <u>ONLY</u> be provided in electronic format. Accordingly, participants are required to bring their own portable computers/laptops configured with Microsoft Windows operating system.

4. Hours of Business:

The official working hours in South Africa are 08:00 am to 16:30 pm from Mondays to Fridays and 09:00 am to 12:30 pm on Saturdays. Saturday afternoons and Sundays are treated as non-corporate time and the banks are closed.

5. Transport:

Peak hour traffic in the Johannesburg/Airport area is to be taken into consideration when planning transportation.

Taxis are available from the airport to the hotels and the fare is normally between R400 - R500. However, it is advisable to agree on the fare before getting into the vehicle. Enquiries may be made at the airport information desks/counters upon arrival.

6. Hotel Information:

Participants are requested to make their own hotel and shuttle reservations. A list of recommended hotels/lodges around the O.R Tambo International Airport area is attached at the end of this bulletin.

7. Entry Visa:

Participants are requested to apply for visas well in advance from South Africa High Commissions or Embassies, which will be issued upon the presentation of documentation showing that the applicants are designated representatives to a particular ICAO related meeting to be held in the Johannesburg area. 8. Health:

Participants must ensure they take out travel insurance (including health) from their home country for the duration of their stay in Kempton Park/ Johannesburg.

Vaccination - Presentation of yellow fever certificate at the point of entry is required for the following African countries – Angola, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Comoros, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo – DRC, Ivory Coast, Ethiopia, Gabon, Ghana, Gambia, Guinea Bissau, Guinea Equatorial, Kenya, Liberia, Mali, Mauritania, Mozambique, Niger, Nigeria, Somalia, Congo, Rwanda, São Tomé e Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Tanzania, Togo, Uganda.

For some African countries Malaria vaccination requirements are also to be confirmed.

9. Weather and Local Time Information:

Annual Weather Averages. January is the hottest month in Johannesburg with an average temperature of 21°C (69°F) and the coldest is June at 10°C (50°F) with the most daily sunshine hours. The wettest month is January with an average of 130mm of rain.

South Africa local time is GMT+2 (UTC). It is fixed across the country.

10. Local Currency and Foreign Exchanges Rates:

The official currency is the South African Rand (ZAR).

The current exchange parity rate as at February 2018 is: 0,084US Dollar (subject to change on a daily basis)

Exchange is easily available in the banks and exchange agencies. Credit cards are accepted in most establishments. Most shops and hotels accept Visa Cards.

11. Telephones:

World-wide direct connections are available, using the international code or telephone operator if necessary. From abroad dial +27 (country code) followed by required number.

There are 4 mobile operators in South Africa: MTN, Vodacom, Cell C and Virgin Mobile. A sim card can be bought at a relatively small fee at various locations, such as cell phone shops and supermarkets. However, the sim card must be registered with the Regulation of Interception of Communications and Provision of Communication-Related Information Act (RICA) before it can be activated. A passport is required in order to register the sim card.

12. Electrical Supply

The electrical outage is 220/240 V at 50 Hz. The plugs are three round pins (big), the earth being 28 mm ($1^{1}/_{8}$ inches). These are used almost exclusively in South Africa, Lesotho and Swaziland.
