This working paper highlights the Challenges encountered in producing the First edition of the AANR and presents recommendations going forward.



02 INTRODUCTION The Annual Air Navigation Reporting Team (AANRT) is comprised of : ACI, AFCAC, AIRBUS, ASECNA, ATNS, CANSO AND IATA (membership is from States, ANSPs and International Organizations), Chairperson and Vicechairperson of APIRG and the ICAO Secretariat.

APIRG/25 noted that the development of the first AFI Air Navigation Report was well advanced despite limited contributions from States and Organizations. The AANRT was encouraged to complete the process and release the Report by 31 March 2023.



03 DISCUSSIONS

- □ Challenges experienced in 2020 2022 continued to be realized in 2023 with lack of data from stakeholders.
- □ the draft was at an advanced stage although with limited information.
- 2023 some more States and ANSPs provided further information that could be used to complement the information earlier provided.
- □ the draft 1st Edition of the AANR is completed (see *attached copy*).

CHALLENGES

a number of challenges were encountered during the preparation and drafting the report:

- Most of the data provided were inform of tables or PDF that was not easy to be transferred into the report and had to be added as attachments.
- The data provided was in many cases very detailed and required to be summarized to fit the report.
- The collection of data from the source was lengthy, requiring a lot of follow-up and persuasion.

An expert to help with the production of the report required.

• Process is lengthy and require specialized expertise for the production of the report.
