- Identify and quantify near term and long term benefits of relevant surveillance candidate systems; and
- c) Develop a consistent draft AFI surveillance implementation plan including recommended target dates of implementation, taking into account availability of SARPs and readiness of airspace users and air navigation service providers for a coordinated implementation of service as required.

J'ai l'honneur de vous informer que le bureau régional de l'OACI pour l'Afrique occidentale et centrale à Dakar, et le bureau régional de l'OACI pour l'Afrique orientale et australe à Nairobi, organisent du 20 au 24 juin un atelier de deux jours sur la Surveillance Aéronautique et la deuxième réunion de l'Equipe de travail pour la mise en œuvre de la Surveillance Aéronautique en Région AFI (AS/I/TF/2). Les deux réunions auront lieu du 20 au 21 juin et du 22 au 24 juin respectivement, dans la salle de conférence de l'Agence pour la Sécurité de l'Aviation Civile en Afrique et à Madagascar (ASECNA), sise 32-38 Avenue Jean Jaurès à Dakar (Sénégal). Votre administration est invitée à y participer.
