Agenda Item 3: Follow-up of SADISOPSG/12 conclusions

The Secretariat will present an overview of the follow up action taken on the SADISOPSG/12 Conclusions.

Agenda Item 4: Operation of the SADIS

Under this agenda item, a concise summary of the complete management report will be presented by the SADIS Provider State. In this context, the SADIS Provider State is expected to present annual statistics related to the non-scheduled OPMET messages received at the SADIS uplink station and to the aerodromes listed in Annex 1 to the SADIS User Guide, from where no OPMET data has been received.

The group is expected to review the updated the list of the SADIS focal points.

The group will review replies received by the Secretariat from SADIS users concerning the operational efficacy of the SADIS during the past year. Based upon the foregoing information, complemented by the report by the SADISOPSG Operational Efficacy Assessment Team, the group will develop the annual statement of the SADIS operational efficacy, to be forwarded to the SADIS Cost Recovery Administrative Group (SCRAG).

The SADIS inventory will be updated by the SADIS Provider State and subsequently reviewed and amended, as necessary, by the meeting, to be forwarded to the SCRAG.

The meeting is expected to consider the implementation of the SADIS in the light of the updated table of SADIS very small aperture terminal (VSAT) installations, to be provided by the Secretary.

Agenda Item 5: Content of the SADIS broadcast

The group will review the OPMET content of the SADIS broadcast in light of the current operational requirements, and in light of the report from the focal point of the EUR OPMET Bulletin Management Group (BMG). In this context, the group is invited to consider singling out in the database containing Annex 1 to the *SADIS User Guide* those aerodromes that issue OPMET data 24 hours a day (GREPECAS Conclusion 14/20 refers).

The group is also expected to review the content of the SADIS broadcast as far as WAFS forecasts are concerned.

Agenda Item 6: Development of the SADIS

The discussions related to the development of the SADIS will be assisted by status reports from the Rapporteurs of the following SADISOPSG teams:

- SADISOPSG Gateway Development Team, including the harmonization of the OPMET content between the SADIS and ISCS broadcasts;
- SADISOPSG Strategic Assessment Team, including analysis of SADIS strategic assessment tables submitted by the PIRGs; and
- SADISOPSG Technical Developments Team, including a report related to the enhancements to the SADIS FTP service.

Under this agenda item, the SADIS Provider State is expected to provide an update of the development related to the alternative SADIS 2G hardware. Furthermore, a report related to the installation and testing of the back-up configuration will be presented by the SADIS Provider State. Finally, an update to the long-term plan of the SADIS development, including the scope and nature of the changes, will be prepared by the SADIS Provider State for endorsement by the group.

Agenda Item 7: SADIS User Guide

The fourth draft edition of the *SADIS User Guide* developed by the SADIS Provider State will be presented by the secretary for endorsement by the group.

Agenda Item 8: Future work programme

The group will review and update its work programme based upon updated executive summaries for each task prepared by the secretary prior to the meeting.

In addition to any other business which may be raised by members, the group is expected to decide on the venue and approximate dates for the next meeting.

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
