<p><b>ACDM-B0</b></p> <p>Aerodrome operators, aircraft operators, air traffic controllers, ground handling agents, pilots and air traffic flow managers share live information that may be dynamic, in order to make better and coordinated decisions. This applies notably in day to day operations and also in case of severe weather conditions or in case of emergencies of all kinds; for these cases A-CDM procedures are referred to in the snow plan, the aerodrome emergency response plan and the aerodrome manual. <p><b>ACDM-B1</b></p> <p>Aerodromes are integrated within the ATM Network, from the strategic through all tactical phases. Situational awareness and decision support information is made available to affected stakeholders to establish a common understanding of the various needs and capabilities and make adjustments to assets in order to cope with these needs.
