3. Registration

- 3.1. Registration of participants will be online as well as take place on Sunday 20th August 2023 from 09:30 am to 16:30pm at the Radisson Blu, Upper Hill Nairobi, Kenva.
- 3.2. The official opening of the Symposium will take place on Monday 21st August 2023 at 09:30am.







4. Language & Communication

- 4.1. The meeting will be conducted in the English and French Languages. Meeting material will ONLY be provided in electronic format. Accordingly, participants are required to bring their own portable computers/laptops configured with Microsoft Windows operating system.
- 4.2. English and Swahili are well spoken in Kenya
- 4.3. Direct worldwide connections are available, using the international code or telephone operator as necessary. From outside Kenya, dial 254 followed by the area code (for landline numbers) and the required number. There are four (4) cellular phone (mobile) operators in Kenya: Airtel, Telkom, and Safaricom.
- 4.4 There shall be free WiFI provided at the Conference Hotel Venue

5. Electricity

5.1. Kenya uses the British system's standard three-pin sockets. The domestic power voltage is 240 volts. Participants are encouraged to ensure compatibility with their gadgets or to have international power adapters.

8. Hotels

8.1. Participants are requested to make their own hotel reservations and indicate that they are attending an ICAO Symposium in order to take advantage of the special accommodation rates. A list of recommended hotels/lodges is attached at the end of this bulletin.

9. Weather and clothing

- 9.1. While Nairobi is very close to the Equator (about 1.30 S), it is located at a relatively high elevation of about 5000 feet (1524m) above mean sea level. In August the mean minimum/maximum temperatures are between 13°C and 26°C.
- 9.2. Nairobi local time is GMT+3.

10. Visa Requirements for Kenya


- 10.1. Participants are advised to ascertain at the respective Embassies whether they are exempt from the Kenyan entry visa requirement.
- 10.2. Kenya visas may be applied for on-line through *http://evisa.go.ke/evisa.html*
- 10.3. In applying for the visa, it is advisable to produce the letter of invitation from ICAO, together with other documents which may be required.
- 10.4. Participants are encouraged to apply for visitor's visa since the requirements are simpler
- 10.5. It is important to apply for visas well in advance.

11. Airport Transfers

- 11.1 Kenya (the host) will provide airport transfers for arriving delegates from the airport to their hotels (among the preferred hotels) or convenient location.
- 11.2 There's availability of popular ride-hailing companies that offer convenient, affordable transportation services through their mobile apps such as Uber and Little Cab. Payments can be done via cash or credit card.







12. Health

- 12.1. It is strongly recommended that participants should have travel insurance (in cluding health) for the duration of their stay in Kenya. Participants should particularly ensure that their insurance is applicable in Kenya. Furthermore, they should carry evidence of current health/hospitalization insurance such as cards that may be produced to health institutions should the need arise. Participants are also encouraged to provide information during registration, on their next of kin who may be contacted on behalf of the participant should the need arise.
- 12.2. Presentation of a valid yellow fever certificate at the point of entry is required for persons who originate from or have travelled to States where yellow fever is described by the World Health Organization (WHO), as endemic, including the following States: Angola, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Comoros, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo, DRC, Ivory Coast, Ethiopia, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea Bissau, Guinea Equatorial, Liberia, Mali, Mauritania, Mozambique, Niger, Nigeria, Somalia, Congo, Rwanda, São Tomé and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Tanzania, Togo and Uganda.
- 12.3. Persons who fail to produce a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate to the port health officials may be required to take the vaccination at the point of entry against payment of US\$15 (subject to change by the appropriate authority). The officials may take other actions in accordance with applicable regulations and procedures. For more information, participants may wish to visit the World Health Organization (WHO)

- 12.4. The following measures shall apply to travelers departing and arriving in Kenya. All travelers arriving into the country through any point of entry shall no longer be required to show proof of either COVID-19 vaccination or a







pre-departure COVID-19 test. Only travelers arriving at any port of entry into Kenya with flu-like symptoms will be required to fill out the passenger locator form on the 'jitenge' platform: https://ears.health.go.ke/airline_registration/ they will also be required to take a COVID-19 antigen test upon arrival at their own cost. Those who turn out positive for antigen tests will be required to take a further COVID-19 PCR test at their own cost. Those with severe symptoms shall thereafter be allowed to isolate as per the prevailing isolation requirements for mild, moderate, and severe disease. Passengers traveling out of the country will be required to abide by the particular travel, health, and COVID-19-related requirements of the transit and destination country. Pre-departure RDT or PCR testing may be considered at the discretion of any of the airlines departing from or terminating in Kenya.

13. Banks

- 13.1. The basic unit of currency is the Kenyan shilling (Kshs.), which is divided into 100 cents. There are silver and bronze coins of 1, 5, 10, 20, and 40 shillings.

 Notes are issued in denominations of 50, 100, 200, 500, and 1000 shillings.
- 13.2. The Kenya shilling exchange rates are determined by the interbank trade which varies daily. Participants may wish to obtain current information from the internet.
- 13.3. Commercial banks and the forex bureau provide exchange facilities. Most banks are open between 9.00 am to 4.00 pm from Monday to Friday and between 9.00 am to 12.00 noon on the first and last Saturday of the month. Some forex bureaus may be open outside these hours. Hotels also offer exchange facilities but at an extra fee and/or less favorable rates. On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA), forex services are available within the customs hall, from 7.00 am to midnight.
