

FIRST MEETING OF THE APANPIRG CONTRIBUTORY BODIES REVIEW TASK FORCE

(Bangkok, Thailand, 23 - 24 May 2011)

Alternative Structure

The following alternative structure is proposed for APANPIRG and its Contributory Bodies.

The proposal is broadly in alignment with the proposed GREPECAS PIRG restructure.

The proposal sees the disestablishment of the ATM/AIS/SAR SG and the CNS/MET SG.

The general organisation sees the tasks of APANPIRG being completed by task forces established with terms of reference, reporting point, time program and authority statement for decisions that can be taken by the task force without reference to APANPIRG.

The work program of APANPIRG is coordinated by a newly established by the Plans and Programs Management Sub Group (PPM SG). The PPM SG is organized as a program/project control group with responsibility for of task forces to development deliver APANPIRG objective as details from the Global Plan and represented in Performance Plan Frameworks. The PPM SG is not responsible for the technical review or endorsement of the product of any task force. Task forces are empowered to approve decisions and conclusions within the scope of the task force's approved work program. Where a decision or conclusion exceeds the approval authorization of the task force the PPM SG packages the draft decision or conclusion for consideration by APANPIRG.

The structure of the concept is illustrated in Figure 1.

The advantage of the proposal is that a layer of bureaucracy is removed and the work program is managed in accordance with project management principals against the APANPIRG endorsed program Global Plan.

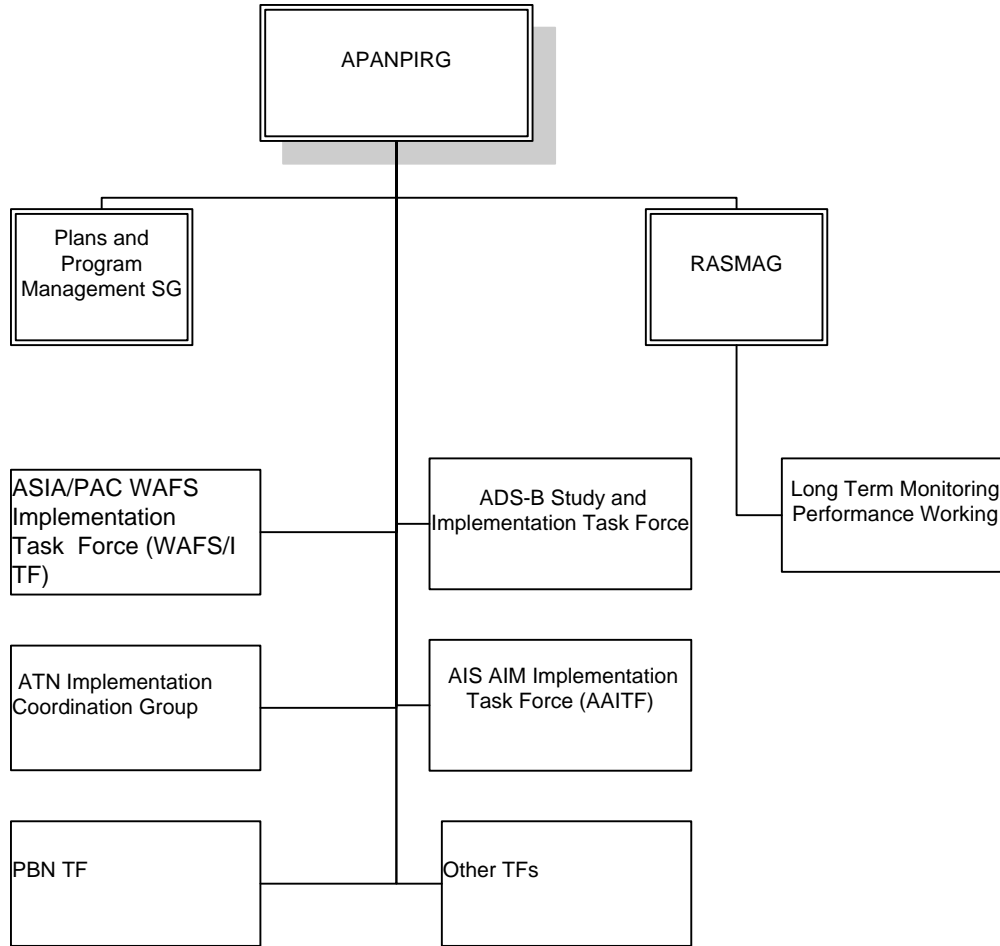
