**REVIEW TERMS OF REFERENCE AND TASKS LIST OF ADS-B STUDY
AND IMPLEMENTATION TASK FORCE**

SUMMARY

This paper presents the decision made by APANPIRG/20 adopting the updated subject and tasks list of ADS-B SITF and the Terms of Reference (TOR) adopted by APANPIRG/18 for review by the meeting.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The ADS-B Study and Implementation Task Force of APANPIRG (ADS-B SITF) review its Terms of Reference (TOR) and Subject/Tasks List at each meeting.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 In light of the progress achieved by the ADS-B Study and Implementation Task Force, the APANPIRG/18 meeting adopted a revised Terms of Reference. It was emphasized that the exchange of information on lessons learnt and experiences gained during the trial and implementation of ADS-B should be further encouraged.

2.2 The ADS-B SITF/9, CNS/MEG SG/14 and APANPIRG/21 meetings did not identify the need to revise the TOR of the ADS-B Study and Implementation Task Force. The TOR was considered appropriate.

2.3 The ADS-B SITF/9 in 2010 updated the List of Subject /Tasks for the Task Force and The APANPIRG/21 held in September 2010 adopted the updated Subject/Tasks List for the ADS-B Study and Implementation Task Force under Decision 21/37 as recommended by the CNS/MET SG/14.

2.4 Some outstanding Action Items are attached to the letter of invitation to this meeting.

2.5 The SEA ADS-B WG/6 Meeting held in February 2011 developed its list of actions items for the Working Group and suggested that some actions need to be progressed and report the status to the ADS-B Study and Implementation Task Force meeting in April 2011.

2.6 The consolidated Tasks List and Action items for review and further updating by this meeting is provided in the Attachment 2 to this paper.

3. ACTION REQUIRED BY THE MEETING

3.1 The meeting is invited to review the TOR of ADS-B Study and Implementation Task Force adopted by APANPIRG/18 as provided in the Attachment 1 and the consolidated List of Subject and Tasks as provided in the Attachment 2 to this paper.

3.2 The meeting is also invited to propose amendment and update to the TOR and the Subject/Tasks List if necessary.

**THE REVISED TERMS OF REFERENCE OF
ADS-B STUDY AND IMPLEMENTATION TASK FORCE**

- Compare currently available technologies with respect to concept of operations, relative costing, technical and operational performance and maturity of alternative technology/solutions (primary, secondary radar including Mode-S, ADS-B, multilateration, ADS-C);
- Develop an implementation plan for near term ADS-B applications in the Asia Pacific Region including implementation target dates taking into account:
 - available equipment standards;
 - readiness of airspace users and ATS providers;
 - identifying sub-regional areas (FIRs) where there is a positive cost/benefit for near-term implementation of ADS-B OUT;
 - developing a standardised and systematic task-list approach to ADS-B OUT implementation; and
 - holding educational seminars and provide guidance material to educate States and airspace users on what is required to implement ADS-B OUT.
- Study and identify applicable multilateration applications in the Asia and Pacific Region considering:
 - Concept of use/operation;
 - Required site and network architecture;
 - Expected surveillance coverage;
 - Cost of system;
 - Recommended separation minimums; and
 - If multilateration can be successfully integrated into an ADS-B OUT system for air traffic control
- Coordinate ADS-B implementation plan and concept of operations with other ICAO regions where ADS-B implementation is going on and with relevant external bodies such as EUROCONTROL, EUROCAE, RTCA and Industry.

Note: The Task Force, while undertaking the tasks, should take into account of the work being undertaken by SAS, AS Panels with a view to avoid any duplication.

The Task Force should report to the APANPIRG, through the CNS/MET Sub-group and provide briefing to the ATM/AIS/SAR Sub-group.
