1. Introduction

This paper provides information to each state's stakeholder about the implementation status of ICAO's 15 November 2012, new flight plan format conversion.

2. Discussions

Current status of Republic of Korea

- 2.1. Republic of Korea has already constructed the conversion system and is preparing for the ICAO transition plan, and the trial operation will continue through the end of June.
- 2.2. Republic of Korea has already educated airspace users for the seamless transition implementation of the NEW FPL and prepared the NEW/PRESENT format conversion. And also, we are going to provide additional education for the airspace users in September to perfectly prepare for it
- 2.3. The AIC has been published to inform that the NEW/PRESENT FPL format will be used simultaneously from 26 July 2012.
- 2.4. Additionally, Republic of Korea will only use the NEW flight plan format from 15 November 2012 based on the ICAO policy.
