SUMMARY

This information paper presents the status update on the Asia/Pacific AMC Information operated by AEROTHAI.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 AEROTHAI has been designated as contact point of the ASIA/PAC Region (Now operates under the Aeronautical Information Management Centre) to coordinate with EUROCONTROL ATS Messaging Management Center (AMC) with regards to the addition/modification of AMHS Information.

2. STATUS UPDATE: CURRENT OPERATION

2.1 At the present, AEROTHAI received the information from 20 Administrations: Australia, Bangladesh, Cambodia, China, Hong Kong China, Macao China, Fiji, India, Indonesia, Japan, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, New Zealand, Pakistan, Republic of Korea, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Thailand and United States.

2.2 The information of some mentioned Administrations are not completed. If any administration would like to update their information, following two forms (attached to this paper) shall be used:

2.2.1 Appendix F – Pro forma for modification of AMHS MD Identifier and/or Addressing Scheme (major change)

2.2.2 AMC Information Form for update AMHS Implementation and other information.

2.3 AEROTHAI will input information received into the AMC Database according to the AMC operation procedure (following AIRAC Cycle).
