MYANMAR'S PROPOSAL FOR RESTORATION OF AFS DATA CIRCUIT

(Presented by Myanmar)

SUMMARY

This paper presents plans for the restoration of AFS data circuit from Myanmar.

1. Discussion

1.1 DCA plans for the restoration of AFS data circuit.

- replace/update present VSAT outdoor unit (ODU) and indoor unit (CU) with new ones. Looking for new outdoor unit/indoor unit and make budget as of June of 2013. If there is a chance to get budget within July of 2013, we would upgrade the VSAST by end of 2013.
- at the same time, DCA Myanmar plans to lease landline 1 E1 (Fiber cable) line from Myanmar Telecommunication Corporation (MPT) between Yangon and Beijing for data and between Yangon and Kunming for ATS voice channel.
- both of above plan will be implemented by June of 2014.
- on the other hand, we would discuss with China for the possible way of replacing indoor and outdoor units of the present VSAT station. Because that station was done by China and also satellite channel leasing charges. We understand that China used China Sat. If China can help, it will be quirkier way to restoration.
- for budget, there is Department budget and the budget from ICAO Technical Cooperation Program. Myanmar DCA account at the TCB still exists. The amount is around some hundred thousands of US Dollars which may be explored for use for this safety enhancement purpose. Further coordination with TCB would be required.
