Signing up for the FAOSD Programme

- How to get started with the FAOSD Programme?
 - Written request from Head of CAA/Administration
 - Nomination of a National Coordinator trained in FAOSD Programme
 - Access to FAOSD Programme from ICAO Regional Office
- Who do I contact?
 - ICAO Regional Office – for initial application
 - email: apac@icao.int
- What's required to participate in the FAOSD Programme?
 - A Ramp inspection programme compatible with ICAO Doc. 8335
 - Competent staff on conduct of ramp inspections and trained on the FAOSD Programme. Proof of FAOSD training by the nominee will be required before granting access rights
