**SUMMARY**

This working paper provides an overview of the level of response on surveys conducted by the Secretariat in support of RASG/APRAST activities.

**1. INTRODUCTION**

1.1 The Region Aviation Safety Group – Asia and Pacific Regions (RASG-APAC) was established following the ICAO Council Decision in May 2010 and supported by the 47<sup>th</sup> Conference of the Directors General of Civil Aviation, Asia Pacific Regions in October 2010. APRAST is the working arm of the RASG.

1.2 For RASG/APRAST to develop and implement effective, relevant and practical safety improvements in the APAC region, there is a need to conduct surveys from time to time to obtain relevant information from APAC States, Operators and Air Navigation Service Providers as applicable.
