HOSTING THE TWELFTH ATNICG WORKING GROUP (ATNICG WG/12)

SUMMARY

This paper informs the members of ATNICG that the Federal Aviation Administration of United States of America is pleased to offer of hosting the ATNICG WG/12 in Seattle, Washington.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 During the ATNICG WG/11, the FAA offered to host ATNICG WG/12 in USA.
- 1.2 The FAA is considering Seattle, Washington to be the venue of this meeting.
- 1.3 The meeting is planned for August or October, 2013 pending budget availability.

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1 At the ATNICG WG/12, the FAA will invite experts and vendors of System Wide Information Service (SWIM), Multi-Protocol Label Switching (MPLS), ED137, and Air-to-Ground service to present their design and service operations.
- 2.2 The FAA will arrange the site visit at Boeing to view the next generation aircraft communication and navigation equipment and operation that will most likely impact our service enhancement.
- 2.3 Due to projected heavy information to be presented at WG/12, the FAA proposes the meeting to be scheduled for four days instead of regular three days event.
- 2.4 Further information will be provided to ICAO Regional Office.

2.5 It is recommended that nominated attendees to provide their information at least 30 days prior to the meeting date to obtain access to meeting venue at US government facility due to security procedure requirement.
