**REVIEW OF THE ANP/FASID – PART VI (MET)**

(Presented by the Secretariat)

**SUMMARY**

This paper presents recent and upcoming updates to Doc 9673, Asia and Pacific Regions Air Navigation Plan – Volume I, Basic ANP and Volume II, Facilities and Services Implementation Document (FASID) – Part VI Meteorology (MET).

**1.       Introduction**

1.1           The FASID contains a detailed description/list of the facilities and/or services to be provided to fulfill the basic requirements of the Air Navigation Plan and are as agreed between the provider and user States concerned. Such agreement indicates a commitment on the part of the State(s) concerned to implement the requirement(s) specified.

1.2           This element of the FASID, in conjunction with the ASIA/PAC Basic ANP, is kept under constant review by the APANPIRG in accordance with its schedule of management, in consultation with user and provider States and with the assistance of the ICAO Asia and Pacific Office, Bangkok. **2.       Discussion**

2.1           Maintaining the Basic ANP and associated FASID Tables MET has many purposes which include: (1) regional planning by operators, (2) measurement of implementation which allows for proper focus in implementation strategies by many entities (Operations, States and ICAO); and (3) input to cost-recovery of MET Services provided for international aviation. Therefore, an annual review of the latest Basic ANP and FASID Tables MET is strongly encouraged.

2.2           The meeting is reminded of the following amendments to the ANP/FASID that have been processed and approved since the last meeting (CNS/MET SG/16) in July 2012:

- *FASID Table MET 2A* (November 06, 2012) – addition of non-AOP aerodrome WADL (Indonesia) and update of RPVD (Philippines) for provision of long TAF (T); (ref: SADISOPSG Conclusion 17/9);

- *Basic ANP, page VI-4* (December 05, 2012) – amended to clearly specify the criteria for the access to the Internet-based services (SADIS FTP/WIFS/Secure SADIS FTP), in light of the global coverage of the public Internet; originated by WAFSOPSG/6 Conclusion 6/4;
- *FASID Table MET 6* (December 07, 2012) – added to clearly specify the criteria for the access to the Internet-based services (WIFS/Secure SADIS FTP) for WAFS forecasts; originated by WAFSOPSG/6 Conclusion 6/4; and
- *FASID Table MET 2A* (January 30, 2013) – Addition of non-AOP aerodromes: YBHM, YBMA, YGEL, YPGV, YPJT, YPKU, YSTW; originated by Australia (ref: SADSOPSG Conclusion 17/9).

2.3 The meeting is also advised that the following proposals for amendment to the ANP/FASID are being processed or pending final approval:

- *Basic ANP, page VI-4* – amended to realign WAFS-related procedures in the ANP; originated by WAFSOPSG/7 Conclusion 7/2;
- *FASID Table MET 5 and Table MET 6* – amended to realign WAFS-related procedures in the FASID; originated by WAFSOPSG/7 Conclusion 7/2;
- *FASID Table MET 1A and Table MET 2A* – updated to reflect current requirements for OPMET at aerodromes in Indonesia, Sri Lanka, Viet Nam and Maldives.

2.4 The FASID was last reviewed at the Eleventh Meeting of the Regional OPMET Bulletins Exchange Working Group (ROBEX WG/11), which agreed to develop the following proposals for amendment to FASID Tables MET 1A, MET 2A, MET 3A and Chart MET 2 for further consideration:

- *Table MET 3A* – realign the boundaries between the areas of responsibility of New Zealand and Australia (as contained in the IAVW Handbook);
- *Chart MET 2* – realign the boundaries between the areas of responsibility of New Zealand and Australia (as contained in the IAVW Handbook); and
- *Tables MET 1A and 2A* – update availability of OPMET at PARO from F – Full to P – Partial.
