**SUMMARY**

This paper presents a progress report and update on the Regional ATFM survey and IATA project undertaken on behalf of the APAC ATFM Steering Group

**1. INTRODUCTION**

1.1 ATFMMSG/2 decision 2/2 refers:

***ATFM/SG Decision 2/2: Asia/Pacific Region ATFM Study***

*That, the APAC ATFM SG agrees to support a project to be funded by IATA which will, for consideration by the ATFM Steering Group and States:*

*1. collate current and planned ATFM initiatives in order to establish a regional baseline view of ATFM capability and interoperability, commencing in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2014; and, based on this information*

*2. develop recommended implementation strategies for collaborative Regional and sub-Regional ATFM;*

**2. DISCUSSION**

2.1 IATA appointed a consultant to carry out the work and commenced the project in April 2014.

2.2 ICAO APAC issued a state letter urging states to participate and IATA and the consultant developed and distributed survey forms to 22 states and 4 organizations within the region. The Survey was developed to update and build on the ICAO 2010 ATFM survey.

2.3 States approached were generally those that attended ATFMMSG/3 with the addition of Laos, Cambodia, Maldives, Sri Lanka, Pakistan and Taipei.

2.4 We received 16 responses from States and responses from the four organisations approached – IATA, AATIP, ICAO and CANSO – a very pleasing result. Responses are detailed in **Table 1**.
