## 1. Schedule of meeting

The opening session of the Meeting will be held at 0900 hours on Monday, 19 January 2015, at the Department of Civil Aviation, Putrajaya, Malaysia.

# 2. Registration of participants

Participants are requested to register at the Registration Desk situated on the 4th Floor, Podium B between 0830 and 0900 hours on the opening day of the Meeting. Participants are also requested to wear the identification badge all the time.

# 4. Passport and visa

All visitors to Malaysia must hold a valid Passport or internationally recognised Travel Document valid for travel to Malaysia. The documents shall be valid, for more than six months from the date of entry. Foreign nationals who require a Visa to enter Malaysia must apply and obtain a Visa in advance at any Malaysian Representative Office abroad before entering the country. #### 5. Currencies and Credit Cards

The unit of currency is Malaysian Ringgit indicated as RM. The current exchange rate is about US\$1 = RM 3.45. International credit cards such as Visa, MasterCard, Amex and Diners Club are accepted at major hotels, departmental stores and restaurants.

#### 6. Time

Malaysia is eight hours ahead of GMT and 16 hours ahead of U.S. Pacific Standard Time.

#### 7. Climate

Malaysia has tropical climate with warm weather all year round.

### 8. Electricity

Voltage is 220 - 240 volts.

# 9. Arrival and Departure

Participants are requested to make their own arrangement for transportation from the airport to the city. KL International Airport (KLIA) operates limousine services from the airport to Kuala Lumpur City (www.airportlimo.my). Public taxi meter service is also available at Level 2 Main Terminal Building KLIA. In addition to the fare, passengers are required to pay the express way toll charges if any.

Various buses at KLIA and Express Rail Link (ERL) KLIA Express provide travellers with to different destinations. Information about the routes and fares are available at www.klia.com.my and www.kliaexpress.com.

When departing, the hotel can arrange for transportation to the airport. Public taxis, which are less expensive than hotel taxis, are also available. Most taxis have a fare meter.

## 10. Transportation to and from Meeting

Participants are requested to make their own arrangements for transportation from their hotels to the venue of the Meeting. Public taxis will be the most convenient choice but some drivers may not be familiar with the location of the venue. Landmark for taxi is **KBS-Kementerian Belia** dan Sukan
