# SINGAPORE'S TRANSPORT SAFETY INVESTIGATION BUREAU

## **SUMMARY**

This paper informs the meeting that the Transport Safety Investigation Bureau is henceforth the air accident investigation authority in Singapore.

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Ministry of Transport (MOT) of Singapore restructured the Air Accident Investigation Bureau of Singapore (AAIB) to form the new Transport Safety Investigation Bureau (TSIB) on 1 August 2016.

#### 2. **DISCUSSION**

2.1 The TSIB will conduct investigations into air and marine accidents and incidents, independently of and separately from any judicial or regulatory proceedings, and make recommendations to enhance the safety of air and sea transport. The sole objective of TSIB's investigations is the prevention of accidents and incidents; they are not for the purpose of apportioning blame or liability.

2.2 The TSIB takes over from the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) the role of conducting independent safety investigations into marine accidents and incidents. MPA will continue to investigate marine accidents and incidents for compliance with its regulations for ships operating within Singapore waters and ships under the Singapore flag.
