Subject: State Safety Programme (SSP) Implementation Course (Bangkok, Thailand, 7 – 11 November 2016)

Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to inform you that the ICAO Asia and Pacific COSCAP Programmes will present a State Safety Programme (SSP) Implementation Course. Support from the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore in releasing Mr. Teo Gim Thong, Principal Training Specialist (Safety Management) - Singapore Aviation Academy, to deliver the course.

The objective of the SSP Implementation Course are to develop participants' knowledge on the Standards and Recommended Practice (SARPs) related to the SSP, the SSP framework and its components, and related guidance material. The course is tailored for representatives from civil aviation authorities with responsibilities regarding the implementation of SSP, and the implementation and/or oversight of Safety Management System (SMS) in the areas of training organizations, aircraft operations, maintenance and airworthiness of aircraft, aircraft design and manufacture, air traffic services, and aerodrome operations.

Included for your action are the course outline (Attachment A), the Nomination Form (Attachment B) and the Bulletin (Attachment C). While the course is opened to all States in the region, it can accommodate up to 35 participants. We therefore, encourage you to submit your formal registration as soon as possible, but not later than 28 October 2016 to help us in finalizing the arrangements.
