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Capacity building

- **Planned development of (or increase in) knowledge, output rate, management, skills, and other capabilities of an organization through acquisition, incentives, technology, and/or training (Business Dictionary)**



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SMART principle

- **Specific** - who should know what
- **Measurable** – how do we measure success
- **Attainable** – practical and cost-effective
- **Relevant** - to the needs of CAPSCA and the individual
- **Time-framed** – achievable within a specific period of time
