
- It is imperative to emphasize that like other regions and sectors of civil aviation, covid-19 has had major impacts on our operations.







- Need for greater interaction and exchange between AFI -ASTCs to share their practices and experiences.

Our Challenges & Responses

- ASECNA's E-Learning platform is in progress to address challenges regarding training material for virtual events
- Available Statistics from ASTCs in Lagos & Nairobi indicate a need for deliberate efforts to get more women to participate in the various Training Programmes.
- The need to bring in other ASTCs on the African Continent into this Forum should be considered.

- The Africa ASTCs have continued to make giant strides in the face of Covid-19 related limitations and dwindling resources.
- Efforts are geared towards the development and implementation of more relevant courses and programmes to help the industry mitigate new and emerging security threats.
