
Roadmap

- The Roadmap covers nine (9) key areas which are:
 - a. Awareness Workshop/Seminar/Symposium:
 - **b.** Policy & Process Articulation
 - c. Enhance Security Reporting System
 - d. Community Relations
 - e. Security Communication
 - f. Standardized /Structured Security Awareness Programme
 - g. Signage, Posters & Announcements
 - h. Increase in Number of AVSEC Instructors
 - i. Functional Training Schedule/Programme and Background Checks

The Journey So Far

- The Federal Airports Authority of Nigeria commenced the actualization of strategies in December 2020.
- First Quarter (Q1) of 2021, Encouraging Strides.

- 3. Enhance collaboration and intelligence gathering.
