2. Registration

3. Opening session:

3.1 The official opening of the Workshop will take place on Tuesday 06 December 2022 at **09:00am**.

4. Working Language, Instruction and Documentation

4.1 The Workshop will be conducted in the English language only. Translation and interpretation facilities will not be available. The Workshop will be paperless. Accordingly, participants are required to bring their own portable computers/laptops for access.

5. Transportation

5.1 From the Airport

Taxis are available from the Airport to the city centre and nearby hotels and the fare is normally between K200 to K500. However, it is advisable to agree on the fare before getting into the vehicle. Enquiries may be made at the airport information desk/counters upon arrival. Alternatively, participants are encouraged to visit https://www.zacl.co.zm/airport-section/transport for a list of registered taxi operators at the Kenneth Kaunda International Airport (KKIA) or download the Yango or Ulendo taxi apps on the play store or app store.

5.2 To the Meeting Venue

Participants will make their own arrangements for Transport from hotels to the Workshop venue and back.

6. Hotel Information

Participants are requested to make their own hotel reservations and a list of recommended hotels, lodges and guest houses near the venue is attached at the end of this bulletin.

7. Entry Visa

7.1 While all travellers arriving in Zambia should have a valid passport, Zambia entry Visas are not required for nationals from some countries. Participants are therefore advised to ascertain whether or not they are exempt from the Zambian entry visa requirements at the respective Zambian Embassies / High Commission. In applying for the visa, it is advisable to produce the letter of invitation from ICAO, together with other documents which may be required by the High Commission or Embassy. It is important to apply for visas well in advance to avoid delays and inconveniences. 8. Health

- 8.1 It is strongly recommended that participants should have travel insurance (including health) for the duration of their stay in Zambia. Participants should particularly ensure that their insurance is applicable in Zambia. Furthermore, they should carry evidence of current health/hospitalization insurance such as cards that may be produced to health institutions should the need arise. Participants are also encouraged to provide information during registration, on their next of kin who may be contacted on behalf of the participant should the need arise.
- 8.2 Presentation of a valid **Covid 19 vaccination Certificate** at the point of entry is required. Those without Covid 19 Certificate shall be required to produce a negative PCR test taken within 72 hours before the date of arrival or departure. Persons who fail to produce a valid covid 19 vaccination certificate to the port health officials may be required to take the vaccination at the point of entry at their own cost. The officials may take other action in accordance with applicable regulations and procedures. - 8.3 Presentation of a valid **yellow fever certificate** at the point of entry is required for persons who originate from or have travelled to States where yellow fever is described by the World Health Organization (WHO), as endemic, including the following States: *Angola, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Comoros, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo, DRC, Ivory Coast, Ethiopia, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea Bissau, Guinea Equatorial, Liberia, Mali, Mauritania, Mozambique, Niger, Nigeria, Somalia, Congo, Rwanda, São Tomé and <i>Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Tanzania, Togo and Uganda*. 9. Weather and Local Time Information

- 9.1 The month of December falls in the Rain season in Zambia with the mean minimum/ maximum temperatures of 17.9% 27.9%
- 9.2 Zambia local time is GMT+2.

10. Local Currency and Foreign Exchange Rates

- 10.1 The basic unit of currency is the Zambian Kwacha (K) and Ngwee (where 100 Ngwee is equal to K1). Zambia currently has six banknotes and four coins in circulation. These are: K100, K50, K20, K10, K5, K2 banknotes K1, 50N, 10N, and 5N coins.
- 10.2 The Zambian Kwacha exchange rates are determined by the interbank trade which varies daily. Participants may wish to obtain current information from the internet or from the Bank of Zambia at https://www.boz.zm/.
- 10.3 Credit cards are normally accepted by banks and most hotels, restaurants and tourist shops. Commercial banks and forex bureaux provide exchange facilities. Most banks are open between 9.00 am to 2.00 pm from Monday to Friday and between 9.00 am to 12.00 noon on the first and last Saturday of the month. Some forex bureaux may be open outside these hours. Hotels also offer exchange facilities but at an extra fee and/or less favourable rates. On arrival at Kenneth Kaunda International Airport (KKIA), forex services are available within the Airport premises. Please change money only from these official places.

11. Telephone

- Worldwide direct connections are available, using the international code or telephone operator as necessary. From outside Zambia, dial 260 followed by the area code (for landline numbers) and the required number.
- 11.2 There are three (03) cellular phone (mobile) operators in Zambia: MTN, Airtel and Zamtel.

12. Security

- 12.1 Zambia is considered a very safe destination, but nevertheless, visitors are advised to take the following general precautions:
 - (a) Do not leave your personal belongings unattended in public places.
 - (b) Avoid carrying large sums of money with you.
 - (c) Avoid displaying expensive jewellery and valuables whilst sightseeing.
 - (d) At night, avoid deserted or poorly lit places.
- 12.2 It is advisable to check with the hotel reception regarding security within the surrounding areas. It is also advisable to use taxis or transport arranged by the hotel reception to visit shopping complexes, to go sightseeing or travel for any other purpose.
