

ICAO RECOMMENDATIONS – POLICIES - DOC 9082



South Africa is a member (**Contracting State**) of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO)



Article 28 of the **Chicago Convention** places on each Contracting State the responsibility for the provision of Air Navigation Services (ANS) in its territory in accordance with **ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices** (SARPs)



The ownership and management of ANS may be delegated to private sector but the overall responsibility for the provision of the services in accordance with ICAO SARPS remains with the State



ICAO recommends that governments may wish to explore the possibility of establishing **autonomous entities** to operate ANS where this is in the best interest of providers and users




