


ACZ Motivation for CAPSCA Assistance Mission



- ❖IHR (2005) mandates States to develop & strengthen core surveillance & response capacities to PHEs at designated international airports.
- The Covid-19 era was a wake up call for ACZ as all our airports were closed with the exception of RGMIA, which however was just servicing (ET Airline) repatriates & humanitarian supplies.
- ❖ To ensure business continuity in the event of resurgence of the pandemic or advent of a new PHE threat we decisively pursued the CAPSCA Assistance Visit Mission to assess, review and strengthen our core capacities at all our designated airports.
- ❖ To get our designated airports listed as safe destinations with international best practices and benefit from positive image and opportunities for business growth.
- ❖ To gain readily access to ICAO/WHO Technical and other resources assistance as we seek to establish Airports Health Centers.


CAPSCA ASSISTANCE MISSION ROADMAP FOR ACZ

Recommendation No. 1



Structural Adjustments

❖ Current Status _ CAPSCA Focal Point.

❖ Recommendation

- ❖ In addition, for the effectiveness and functionality of the Collaborative arrangements, we advocate for CAPSCA to recommend to states and recognize a <u>CAPSCA Focal Committee</u> which comprises of <u>at least</u> three appointees from (<u>Public Health</u>, <u>Civil Aviation Authority</u>, <u>Airport Authority</u>) where the Capsca Focal Point is also a member of that committee. This will function as a steering committee.
- * We also advocate for a platform for Accounting officers (resource providers) from **PHA**, **CAA** and **Airport Authorities** to have consultative forums coordinated by CAPSCA to discuss PHE management issues as part of efforts to strengthen the collaborative efforts.

❖ Benefits

- □ Improves collaborative efforts between the PHA, CAA and Airport Authority (Airport Stakeholders). Destroys barriers of collaborative efforts by entities once adopted as a recommended practice by CAPSCA to its member states.
- ☐ The recommendation may help address a number of issues presented on the CAPSCA Africa updates, Collaboration Barriers.

Recommendation No. 2



Structural Adjustments

- ❖ <u>Current Status</u> <u>CAPSCA Assistance Mission is voluntary.</u>
- **❖** Recommendation
- * We advocate for a CAPSCA accreditation process for States but obviously with levels, with the current arrangement being probably the voluntary level where requirements then intensify towards accreditation for states that want to be accredited as an assurance process to the travelling public and potential business partners (airlines). A business case paper can be done for consideration.
 - ❖ Level 1 Voluntary, Technical Assistance Visit.
 - Level 2 (JEE and CAPSCA Protocol with evaluation scoring). Level 3, Evidence Based Collaborative efforts of Agencies (CAA, PHA, Airports)
- ❖ A similar concept to ACA, lessons learnt from Covid-19 call for robust initiatives in terms of pandemic preparedness hence the need to create tools that motivate states to do more.

❖ Benefits

□ Accreditation will demonstrate to the World that a state has in place necessary tools to handle a PHE as an Assurance Mechanism.
