CONSIDERATIONS OF AFI REGULATORY

FRAMEWORK

- The Group deliberated for the need to:
- 1. There is need for ICAO to urge States to develop PRIMARY LEGISLATION applicable to both the Civil and Military Authorities. Usual processes through parliament.
- 2.Being parties to Chicago Convention, States are urged to implement Resolution A40-4: Appendix I Coordination and Cooperation of Civil and Military.

IMPLEMENTATION PROCESS



- Primary Legislation that will involve both Civil and Military Authorities.
- States then to develop applicable regulations as they may deem fit.

SOPs

- Operational Manuals for both Civil and Military.
- Guidance Material for Coordination, Collaboration and Cooperation.

IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGIES

Political Will- Buy In

- Develop structure in line with Doc 10088.
- Involve High level Military and Political forum to drive the buy in of our political leaders.
- Need for ICAO Assembly to provide a platform for political leaders to agree on Assembly resolutions . States represented at High level.
- Regional bodies (AU, SADC, EAC) to share experience and encourage States to implement ICAO Assembly Resolutions
- More participation of High level Military Personnel at ICAO Meetings

IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGIES



- Perform a gap analysis against the existing baseline in terms of structures, cooperation and coordination mechanisms. Use the format provide by ICAO.
- Organize workshops to sensitize the key stakeholders.
- Prepare all documentations –ToRs, Letters of Nominations, Letters of Appointments for members, invitation for inauguration, presentations for meetings,
- Inaugurate and Establish Civil Military Committee Board and Committees according to Doc 10088.

IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGIES

Change Management

- Devise change management strategies such as change communication (Awareness workshops, Town Hall Meetings)
- Building Trust amongst key Stakeholders(Internal and External) through honest discussions.

Information sharing

- Access to real time information to be provided on a need to know basis.
- Confidentiality agreement amongst stakeholders if need be.

CONCLUSION

Group One drew up the following Recommendations:

- Primary Legislation to by followed by the regulations, manuals, guidance materials, SOPs, etc.
- Use of top bottom approach for Civil Military structure
- The need for institutional framework in accordance with Doc 10088.
- Continuous sensitization of the stakeholders including any changes.
- The need for regional bodies to drive political Will which is a key challenge.
 - The need for an updated GAP analysis
