# CART Report includes 11 Recommendations

## **For the aviation public health-related measures:**

**Recommendation 4:** Global and regional harmonization of procedures is essential to strengthen public and passenger confidence in air travel. To that end, Member States should establish aviation public health procedures aligned with the guidance in the *Take-off: Guidance for Air Travel through the COVID-19 Public Health Crisis*.

**Recommendation 5:** In order to support the fastest possible return to normal aviation operations, Member States should regularly review the necessity of continuing the application of risk mitigation measures as the risk of COVID-19 transmission diminishes; and measures which are no longer needed should be discontinued.

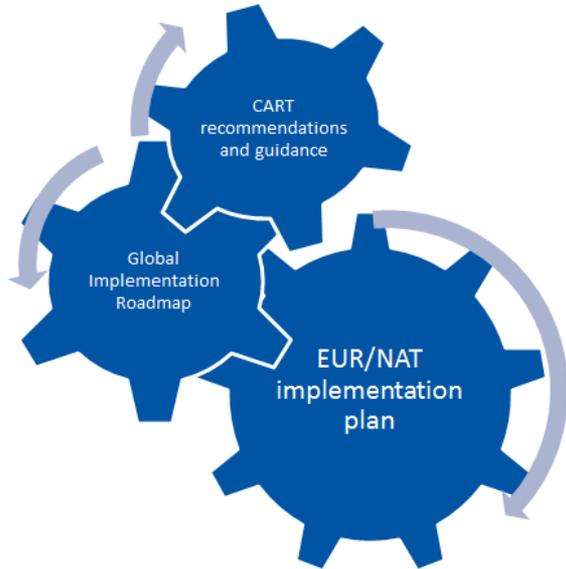

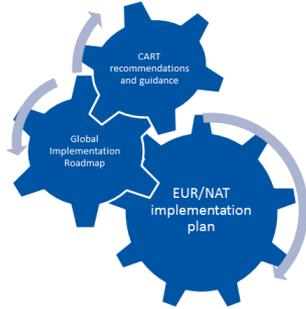
## Way forward

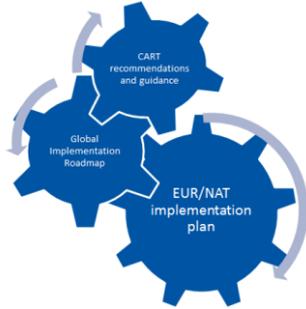
- **States to implement the recommendations in coordination with ICAO Regional Offices and according to the respective regional plans.**

## Defining roles of EUR/NAT DGCA, EASPG, NAT SPG and ENAVSECG for implementation support and coordination

- High-level strategic discussions/coordination at the DGCA level
- Feedback on CART and GIR updates and progress of implementation
- Regionally harmonised updates of CCRD and CRRIC
- Regionally harmonised guidelines for implementation
- CAPSCA EUR capacity building activities and training for CART PH measures
- Implementation of AVSEC/FAL guidelines for aviation security contingency and Facilitation measures during COVID-19 pandemic
- NATFC and cross sectoral cooperation AVSEC-FAL via NATFC/NCASC

## ICAO EUR/NAT and EASA: a common letter to EUR/NAT States with the objective of showing a common response to the crisis:

- Refers to the **EASA/ECDC protocol** as aligned acceptable means of compliance to implement the CART Guidelines and Take-off Document.
- An **Annex** highlighting the **high level differences** between EASA/ECDC guidelines and CART.
- Both documents will evolve over time based on the latest scientific evidence and **each party will cooperate to align** their guidance with the next update.
- **Explains how the reporting** on the implementation of both guidelines **will work**.
- Focuses **only on Recommendation 4** (PH measures alignment) of the CART report.
