What We Do

AVP-420 manages the NTSB and FAA Safety Recommendation Programs for the Agency.

- NTSB Safety Recommendations are issued to the FAA following NTSB investigation of an accident/incident, study, etc.
- FAA Safety Recommendations are submitted by:
 - Any FAA employee who identifies a safety concern, or
 - International civil aviation authorities.
- Other tasks include support for the FAA's Performance Management Review and preparation of the FAA's response to the NTSB's Annual Most Wanted List



5,026 Total NTSB Recommendations Received







AVP-420 Ensures that FAA responses:

- Answer questions asked by the Board;
- Explain changes in direction from previous responses;
- Explain technical issues fully;
- Address senior management comments and questions; and
- Meet consistency standards.

Responses are...

- Coordinated through assigned Program Office Directors, ARM-1 (if necessary), AVP-1, AVS-1, and the Administrator
- Coordinated with stakeholders providing input on General Aviation Joint Steering Committee, Commercial Aviation Safety Team, and Safety Management System safety issues.
- Coordinated in accordance with congressional deadlines (initial responses are due to the NTSB in 90 days)

Program addresses two types of recommendations:

(1) Domestic recommendations

- Submitted by any FAA staff member
- Must be safety-related

(2) International recommendations

Submitted by foreign civil aviation authorities

In the last decade alone, we received on average <u>over 300 FAA</u> <u>safety recommendations per year</u> resulting in more than :

- 674 Airworthiness Directives (ADs)
- 960 Safety Bulletins
- 149 Notices of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRMs)
- 983 Handbook Changes
- 608 Maintenance Alerts
- 2331 other types of safety enhancements

Continues to be one of the most valuable tools at the FAA's disposal to collect and disseminate safety enhancements to the national and international aviation community.
