---

CAPSCA is based on a solid fundament:

- ❖ WHO: International Health Regulations (IHR 2005)
- ❖ ICAO Legal Framework: Standards, Regulations, Recommendations
- ❖ CAPSCA: Guidelines, Templates
- ❖ Industry (IATA, ACI etc.): Guidelines, Recommendations, Templates

# The expertise needed...

---

A CAPSCA Technical Advisor usually is a representative of a CAPSCA Member State, either from the national Public Health or the Civil Aviation Authority.

They are nominated by their Authority.

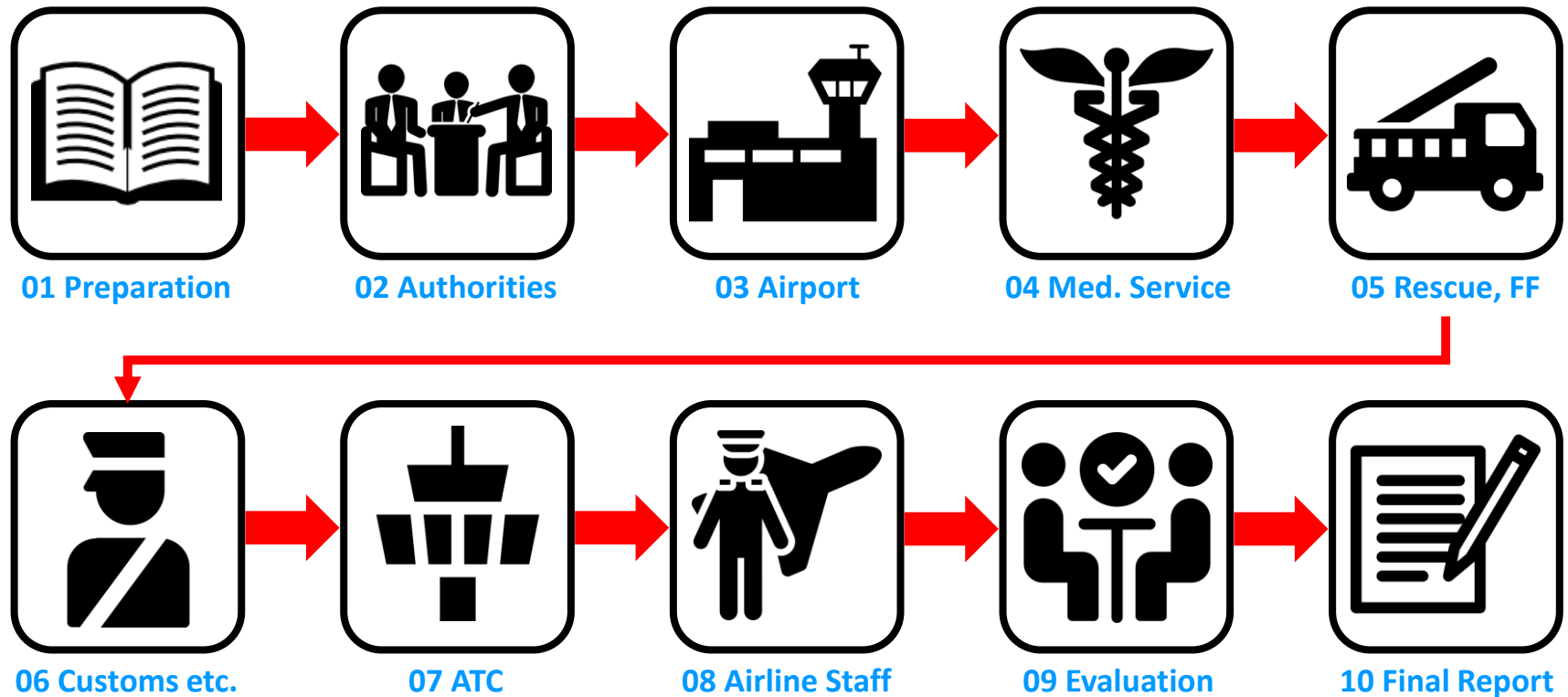
A CAPSCA Technical Advisor is an experienced Pro in the field of Public Health and/or Civil Aviation.

A TA is up-to-date regarding the relevant legal basis.

He/she has the ability to perform a Visit in a competent, diplomatic, sympathetic and determined manner.

# What a future TA – you? – will do...

---

You enroll in the CAPSCA TA Course at JAA TO.

It will take about 32-35 hours of work: studying regulations, reading, performing quizzes and mastery tests, exchanging experience with other international students.

Once you completed successfully the Course, you will be on ICAO's CAPSCA Technical Advisors List. You can be asked by ICAO to perform a TA Visit in another CAPSCA Member State.

You will gather a lot of experience – and competence!

# The Outcome

---

A CAPSCA trained Technical Advisor is able:

- ❖ to act as a TA Visit Team member;
- ❖ to perform a TA Visit to a foreign Country and Airport;
- ❖ to deal with high ranking State Authority representatives;
- ❖ to evaluate the condition of the visited State and Airport;
- ❖ to consider the local situation of the State visited;
- ❖ to give competent recommendations for improvement;
- ❖ to write a suitable and coherent Final Visit Report.
