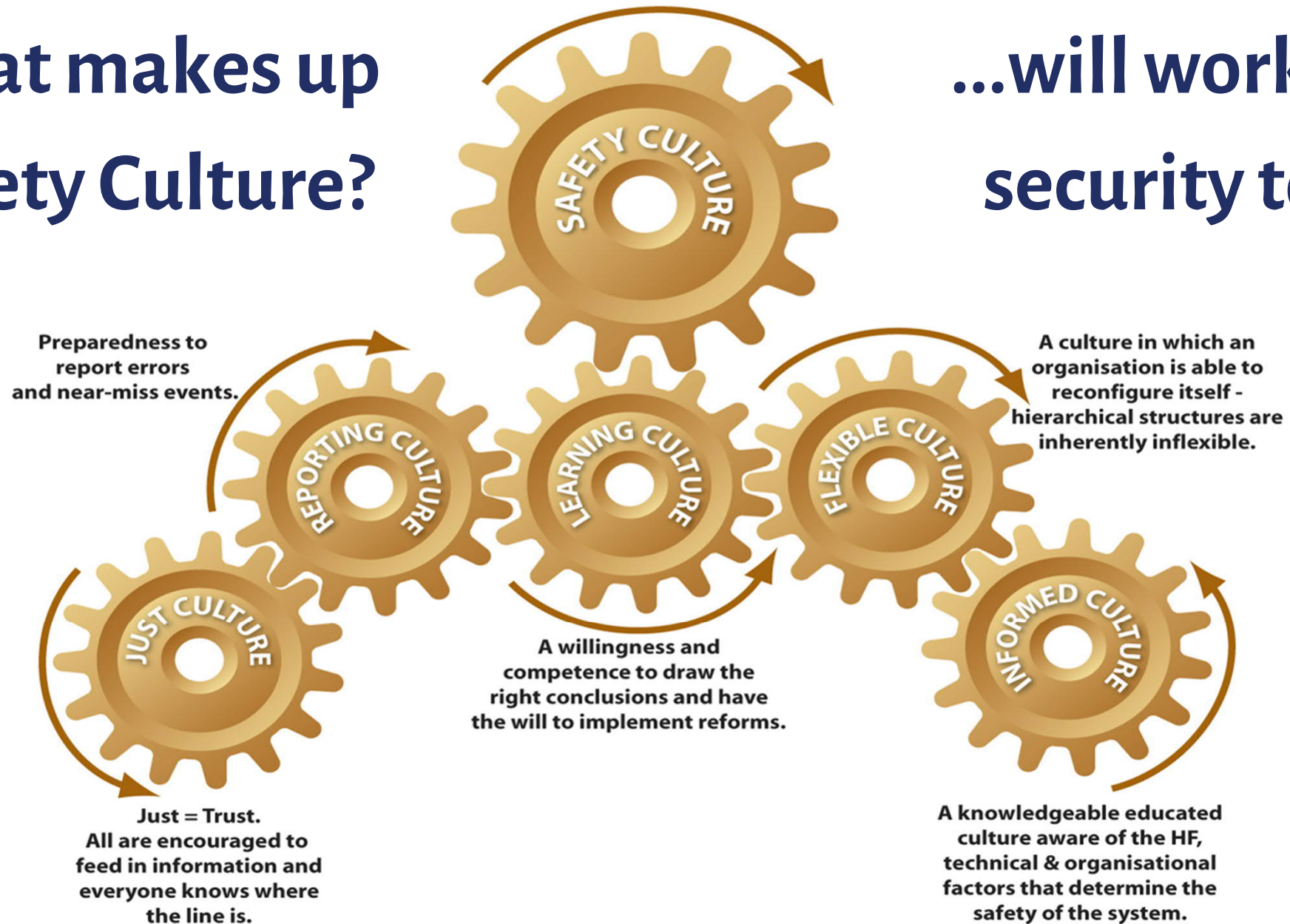
Safety Culture for Safe Outcomes
