WHAT IS ATFM



Air Traffic Flow Management (ATFM) is an enabler of air traffic management (ATM) efficiency and effectiveness.

ICAO Doc 9971

A concept of balancing air traffic demand and capacity through:

Spacing Restrictions

Rerouting

Ground Holding

Airborne Holding





WHY ATFM



ATFM contributes to the safety, efficiency, cost effectiveness, and environmental sustainability of an ATM system.

To ensure that safety is not compromised whenever the traffic demand in an airspace or at an aerodrome is forecast to exceed the available capacity



ATFM ENABLERS IN THE UAE



UAE Airspace Policy includes an ATFM policy statement.

The <u>UAE Air Traffic Management Strategic Plan</u> that supports the evolution to a future ATM system in the United Arab Emirates that is performance-based, addresses ATM community expectations, is cost-efficient and globally harmonized.

CAR PART VIII Sub Part 4 provides ATFM regulatory requirements.

<u>UAE Airspace Coordination and Contingency Cell</u> Airspace users/ANS providers could share any operational information which could impact Air Traffic Operations in the UAE FIR and beyond

Collaborative Air Traffic Flow Management (ATFM) study and operational trial. The output shall result in a concept of operations specific to the UAE environment.





- To facilitate the smooth implementation of all required ATFM measures by:
 - Ensuring that the UAE CAR makes provision for ATFM.
 - Regulate Civil Aviation activities to achieve safe and secure civil aviation systems
 - Ensure adherence to the regulatory requirements
 - Certification / Approvals
 - Authorizations / Licensing
 - Through effective oversight systems (Audits, Inspections)





- The regulator facilitates the development of ATM (which includes ATFM)enhancements and technologies though the following:
 - Through introducing policies and regulations that will accommodate such developments for ATM stakeholders
 - Example 1: The airspace policy which was published and included a clear statement that the UAE will be implementing ASBU modules – including ATFM concept.
 - Example 2: The UAE ATM strategic plan which was published and includes timelines and priorities for implementing ATFM
 - Example 3: ATFM is authorised through CAR PART VIII sub part 4





> Collaboration with international / regional organizations

By:

- Participating at ICAO Panels and working groups to allow your industry to shape global developments
- Host seminars and workshops to provide opportunity for awareness and training
- Share and exchange practices with international / regional partners to accommodate lessons learnt within your national plans





- ➤ Fostering National plans through establishing technical / advisory committees
- Example 1: National Airspace Advisory committee / National ATC Technical committee / National AIM technical committee / National CNS technical committee / National Aerodrome Technical committee
- Example 2: Established an Internal UAE ATFM work group under the National Airspace Advisory Committee (NASAC)

Note: the above committees are all facilitated by GCAA regulator and consists of all ATM stakeholders including ANSPs, airports and operators with the aim of developing national plans.



REGULATOR ACTIONS



CURRENT

- Provide regulatory guidance, processes and procedures
- Provide Guidance to the UAE ATFM work group
- Report Implementation progress to ICAO MID
- Continue support to the ICAO ATFM work group

FUTURE

- Continue to develop the Regulations as technology and systems mature
- Continue report Implementation progress to ICAO MID
- Ensure ATFM status published in the UAE AIP as applicable
- Ensure sufficient training to Organizations in order to facilitate the implementation of ATFM
- Ensure GCAA Inspectors are trained in order to provide efficient oversight

CONCLUSION

- ATFM measures are restrictive in nature and should be kept to the minimum.
- States must ensure that their ATM policy, plans and regulation includes facilitation of ATFM.
- Collaboration is essential (National, Regional, International)
