1.2 The Second Meeting of the MID Region ATM Enhancement Programme Board (MAEP Board/2) was held in Cairo, Egypt, 11-13 April 2016. The Fifth meeting of the MIDANPIRG Steering Group (MSG/5) was also held in Cairo, Egypt, from 18 to 20 April 2016.

#### 2. DISCUSSION

2.1 The meeting may recall that each MIDANPIRG subsidiary body is tasked with the follow-up on the implementation process related to its Terms of Reference and to inform MIDANPIRG on progress, achievement, and problems being encountered.
