Sir / Madam,

I have the honour to inform you that the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and the World Customs Organization (WCO) are jointly organizing a workshop on Air Cargo Security and Facilitation that will be held at the *Customs and Excise Administration*, Avenue Annakhil – Hay Riad, Rabat, Morocco, from 17 to 20 October 2016. This Workshop is designed to bring together relevant experts and stakeholders in the fields of customs and air cargo security to discuss the international air cargo secure supply chain and its governing rules and standards.

The Workshop will also provide participants with the opportunity to share experiences and identify synergies in customs and civil aviation security processes with the aim of further improving the facilitation of air cargo. The target audience for the Workshop includes National Authorities responsible for the development and oversight of air cargo security policies and procedures, Customs administrations and representatives from regional organizations.

For your information, invitations to the Customs organisations of States were transmitted directly through the World Customs Organisation (WCO). In order to achieve the objective of the Workshop to facilitate cooperation and coordination in maintaining the integrity of the air cargo supply chain, ICAO requests that your Administration/Organization also nominates one (1) participant from the appropriate Authority responsible for Air Cargo security policy development and oversight to attend the Workshop. This individual should be an aviation security expert at the senior level with direct responsibility for the formulation and oversight of implementation of policies and procedures related to the security of Air Cargo. As the aim of the Workshop is to assist aviation security and customs organisations develop mutual understanding, coordination and cooperation in their endeavours, your assistance in liaising with your relevant counterparts in your State's Customs authority would be appreciated in order to ensure attendance from both parties.

It is to be highlighted that the Workshop will be conducted in English with simultaneous interpretation into Arabic.
